

# Ranked Choice Voting Problems

- Computers calculate election outcomes, instead of people (hard to audit)
- Mail-in ballots and ranked choice voting are stepping stones to losing our privacy to the Blockchain
- Ranked Choice Voting eliminates the Supreme Court ruling of One Person = One Vote
- Ranked Choice Voting eliminates any bargaining power of a 3rd Political Party
- Ranked Choice Voting removes the moral obligation of the voter to keep their winner accountable: they can't verify that they voted for the winner.
- It waters down candidates' political opinions. A candidate wants to keep the option of being a voter's 2nd choice.
- Ranked Choice Voting eliminates poll watching.
- Ranked Choice Voting puts our trust in Big Tech, and leaves Big Tech the only way to verify elections.
- Ranked Choice Voting increases the influence of big billionaire money.
- Ranked Choice Voting is confusing; particularly for minorities.

## — In-Person (with ID) Voting Solutions —

- Easy to audit
- Poll-watchers increase trust and can verify accuracy
- Local control of the entire process
- Not centralized and keeps the separation of powers
- Respects the sacred vote of each citizen
- Healthy community involvement
- Fulfills the voter/state contract
